## Note

- ☐ Response when an alarm is issued
  - (1) Regardless of typhoon or tropical storm, if the condition 2 or lower is announced from the day before to the school attendance time, the school will be closed at the instruction of the Guam government and the judgment of the principal.
    - \* The school will be closed even if the conditions are changed on the way.
  - (2) The final decision is 6 o'clock in the morning.
  - (3) The school will contact you by email regarding temporary closures and other measures.
  - (4) In case of condition 3, it is normal school attendance. However, if you are absent or late at your own discretion, you will be attending.
